Services:

- **Information Literacy Instruction** provided in one of three computer classrooms, or campus classrooms.
- **Reference/Information Service** available in-person, mail, electronic, email, or telephone.
- **Online catalog, electronic services, and research databases** are accessible by all Faculty, Staff, Students in the library, any on-campus location, and via remote access, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- **Interlibrary Loan Services** for Faculty, Staff, and Students.
- **Hardcopy, online, electronic, course reserves** for Faculty.
- **Over 300 computer workstations (Mac and PC)** are available to UTEP Faculty, Students, and Staff.
- **Wireless laptops** available for checkout in the Technology Support Center.
- **Meeting / Event rooms** with audio-visual support (Rooms: Blumberg Auditorium, 309, and 410).
- **Library Tours** for students and visitors.
- **Photocopying** (self-serve).

OTHER SERVICES IN LIBRARY:

- **Collaborative Learning Center** offers over 300 Computers for student and faculty use, with a variety of software applications and access to email, the internet, and other resources.
- **Technology Support Center** houses the university Help Desk, technical assistance, and training.
- **University Writing Center** offers free drop-in writing tutoring for all students, freshman to graduate.
- **Math Resource Center for Students (MaRCS)** is the Math tutoring center for all students.
- **Military Student Success Center**, "a one-stop shop" for military students and their dependents.
- **Jazzman's Coffee Shop** open most Library hours, serving food and beverages.

Current Periodicals (2nd floor) and Media & Microforms (1st floor): journals, newspapers, government documents, special microform collections, audio-visual materials.

Government Documents & Maps (publications issued by the United States and Texas; extensive map collection; strong concentration in Geology & Congressional hearings).

Special Collections (rare books, art, Western fiction, Chicano studies, *Judaica*, border studies, book arts, military history, oral history, manuscripts and archives, photographs, and historical maps) includes: over 600 manuscript collections and 81 photograph collections. Archives total 8,116 linear feet.
